The results of the video competition under the name **"CITIZENSHIP PARTICIPATION AND YOUTH ACTIVITY IN THE BALTIC SEA COUNTRIES WITH THE EYES OF THE SB YCGN PROJECT"** organized by the Association of Polish Communes Euroregion Baltic, as part of the SB YCGN project.

The selection took into account the commitment, effort put into the preparation of the technical side of the clip and understanding of the topic.
